"Living in the Light of the Resurrection"

The resurrection of Jesus Christ stands as the cornerstone of the Christian faith, offering hope and redemption to all who believe. In 1 Corinthians 15:20, Paul writes, "But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep." As those mentioned, Jesus' resurrection assures us of our own future resurrection and eternal life. This truly shapes our identity as the Church, quiding us to live in the constant awareness of the

resurrection's transformative power. Living in light of the resurrection means continually celebrating, remembering, and embracing a life of victory over sin and death, all thanks to Jesus. Romans 6:9 says, "We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him." Just as death has no power over Christ, it now has no power over us who are in Him. This truth empowers us to overcome sin, fear, and death by walking in the freedom and authority granted by Jesus, our resurrected Savior. All because of this, the resurrection calls us to a life of purpose and mission. In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus commissions his disciples, saying, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." Our mission as the Church is grounded in the reality of Christ's resurrection. We are called to proclaim the good news of salvation, inviting others into the "Family of God," so they may experience the same transformative relationship with Jesus that we have. Practically for us, what does this mean? That living in light of the resurrection involves daily renewal and transformation. Romans 12:2 says, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect." As we align ourselves with Scripture, engage in prayer, and participate in community with other believers, we open ourselves to the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit, who conforms us to the image of Christ. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is not just a historical event but a reality of "today" that shapes every aspect of our lives as the Church. We must continually live because of this truth, embracing victory over sin, fulfilling our mission with purpose and excitement, and should be transforming daily into the likeness of Christ. As we do, would we have strength, hope, and inspiration from the resurrection, knowing that we serve a risen Savior who has conquered death and offers abundant life to all who believe.
