

A WORD FROM A PASTOR ADAM SMITH - PASTOR OF DISCIPLESHIP



"The Discipleship Cycle"

"You every thought about how you learned certain facts? Random facts for identifying snakes like, "if red touches yellow you're a dead fellow; if red touches back, you're okay jack." How about being warned against eating the first snowfall of the year? I know I am constantly amazed at hearing my young children repeat songs of expressions they have heard. The other night two of them were singing a popular hymn to which we like to listen. They have been

immersed in it. There are some things, we might not recount where exactly we heard it or learned it, but we know it. We know it because we have been immersed in with it as others have passed things along to us. The work of discipleship is a lot like a child learn lyrics, habits, or expressions. Someone taught them and reinforced it by modeling it over and over again. Paul wrote to his spiritual son in the faith Timothy on at least two occasions. In 2 Timothy 2:2, Paul instructs Timothy to teach what he has heard (or learned) from Paul to other faithful men (in the presence of other witnesses) who will then go on to teach others. This is a discipleship cycle. Our lives are to be invested in pouring the Gospel of Christ and the ways of Christ into the lives of others. We are to be constantly learning from those who are around us and teaching those coming up behind us. Like links in a chain, we are constantly held secure by the grace of God from more mature believers and link ourselves to others coming after us. The links are all attached back to the faith once and for all delivered to the saints, the one, true Gospel.

Reflect and ask yourself:

How are you growing as a disciple?

Who is growing as a disciple because of you?

How is the Gospel going forward through you as you seek to share with other?"
